**Animal Services announced new adoption hours**

Fort Myers, FL, June 22, 2015 – Lee County Domestic Animal Services will be opening its Pet Adoption Center an hour earlier effective immediately. The new hours are 10:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday through Saturday. The shelter is currently at capacity so the additional hour each day will give adopters more time to select the pet that's right for their family.

Adopters can also submit their application online prior to coming to the shelter so they will have even more time to visit with the cats, kittens, dogs and puppies waiting for new homes. Volunteers and staff also will be on hand to assist with the selection process and answer any questions.

Animal Services' Lost and Found Pet Center remains open from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Saturday for anyone looking for a missing pet and for the intake of pets found by the public. The Spay Neuter Clinic hours, 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday through Friday, are also unchanged. Pet microchipping is available at the clinic on a walk-in basis from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m., Monday through Friday excluding holidays.
