1. REQUESTED MOTION:

ACTION REQUESTED: Approve grant award from the Department of Juvenile Justice in the amount of \$20,000 to provide training, travel expenses and hiring a part-time coordinator for the Neighborhood Accountability Boards. Establish a budget for the Neighborhood Accountability Boards from the Department of Juvenile Justice in five Neighborhood Districts (Charleston Park, Dunbar, Harlem Heights, Page Park and Pine Manor).

The part-time coordinator position will be contracted out.

<u>WHY ACTION IS NECESSARY</u>: To provide funding in the amount of \$20,000 from the Department of Juvenile Justice for training, travel expenses, and contracting with a part-time coordinator to assist in the coordination of the Neighborhood Accountability Boards in the five Neighborhood Districts.

<u>WHAT ACTION ACCOMPLISHES</u>: Provides funding to contract with a coordinator to assist in the formation of Neighborhood Accountability Boards to address juvenile offenders, victims, and the address the victimization of the neighborhoods. In addition, funding will provide the resources for Lee County Department of Human Services staff to participate in state-wide training.
