7. BACKGROUND: Lee County condemned 4.22 acres of land (Parcel 100A) and .62 acres of land (Parcel 100B) from two tracts of vacant land south of Corkscrew Road held by Dwight Baird, Trustee. The land was condemned for the Three Oaks Parkway Extension Project. Lee County's initial offer was \$615,000.00 which includes land value and severance damages to the portion bisected by the road. The owner's appraiser estimates \$1,393,000.00 is due. The owner offered to accept \$950,000.00 plus interest, costs and fees. The County Attorney recommends the Board reject this offer and make a proposal for settlement of \$750,000.00.
