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INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT

THIS INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 22 day of FBRUNC , 2002, by and between the Lehigh Acres Fire Control District, an independent fire district organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Florida, (herein referred to as "LHAFCD") and LEE COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, (hereinafter referred to as "County").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Florida Interlocal Cooperation Act of 1969, F.S.

163.01, was promulgated to permit local governmental units to make the most efficient use of their power by enabling them to cooperate with other governmental units, thereby providing services and facilities in a manner and pursuant to forms of governmental organization that will accord best with geographic, economic, population and other factors influencing the needs and development of local communities; and

WHEREAS, the County and LHAFCD are desirous of entering into an agreement for he purposes of assigning State EMS Grant Money,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS AGREED AND UNDERSTOOD BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE.

The County will assign funds in the amount of \$7,231.00 to the LHAFD for the purpose of expanding and improving emergency medical services in their area of operation.

SECTION TWO.

The LHAFCD agrees to expend the funds in accordance to the line item budget listed in Attachment A which is hereby incorporated by reference.

SECTION THREE.

Failure of LHAFCD to use the funds for the purposes outlined shall result in a forfeiture of the funds utilized for purposes inconsistent with this agreement.

SECTION FOUR.

Upon request by the County, the LHAFCD shall within thirty (30) days give an accounting of the expenditure of funds pursuant to this agreement.
