1. REQUESTED MOTION:

ACTION REQUESTED: Approve Bid Waiver # W-020414 to waive the formal quotation procedure and allow the Lee County Division of Public Safety to purchase 10/20 Upgrade Kits from Sprint, Florida, this equipment is an upgrade that will facilitate the ability of the 9-1-1 equipment to read up to 20 digits of the telephone number. The request is for funds from the 9-1-1 Wireless User Fee not to exceed \$65,000.00. A bid waiver has been requested, as Sprint, Florida is a sole source vendor for the 9-1-1 equipment. Funding will come from the individual departments budget and they will be responsible for monitoring their own expenditures.

WHY ACTION IS NECESSARY: According to Section 9.4.1 of the Lee County Purchasing and Payment Procedures Manual, approved by the Board on 3/21/00, purchases over \$50,000.00 must be approved by the Board.

WHAT ACTION ACCOMPLISHES: The purchase will meet the FCC 9-1-1 Wireless Phase I mandate requirements.

The purpose of this memo is to request your assistance to submit a Blue Sheet to the Board of County Commissioners for the 9-1-1 equipment upgrade from Sprint, Florida for 10/20 FCC Wireless Phase I compliance.

Brief description of the equipment as follows: 10/20 upgrade kits from Sprint include the electronic programmable memory computer chips that facilitate the ability of the 9-1-1 equipment to read up to 20 digits of the telephone number. The existing equipment currently reads seven digits using our common area code (941) and only requires the 7-digit identification. With the advent of cellular 9-1-1 calls containing many foreign area codes, the FCC has mandated that the 9-1-1 centers have the capability to read the full 10 digits.

ACTION REQUESTED: To approve an upgrade of the existing countywide 9-1-1 System to the 10/20 digit standard. The request is to approve Sprint as a sole source vendor for the 9-1-1 equipment with an open-ended bid waiver. The request is for funds from the 9-1-1 Wireless User Fee not to exceed \$65,000.

WHY ACTION IS NECESSARY: The request is for approval of funds over \$50,000 and to approve an open ended bid waiver which requires Board authorization.

WHAT ACTION ACCOMPLISHES: This purchase will meet the FCC 9-1-1 Wireless Phase I mandate requirements.

BACKGROUND: The Lee County 911 Program is responsible for the maintenance and operation of the 9-1-1 system and equipment throughout Lee County. The 9-1-1 Wireless User Fee is collected from all cellular telephone users in Lee County and the funds are used in accordance with the rules and regulations of the 911 State Plan fs 365.171. The FCC's 9-1-1 Wireless Phase I mandates are intended to provide the same level of service to the cellular user as currently provided the residential land line user.

Sprint is pleased to provide Lee County with the following proposal for upgrading Lee County's PSAP's to meet the requirements for the FCC Phase 1 mandates.

The <u>FCC Phase I</u> mandates that call centers will be able to capture and display not only the 10 digit telephone number of the wireless caller but also the 10 digit telephone number of the cell site that the caller last connected through. If the caller is disconnected or lost the call taker will still have the identity of the cell tower and can plot its location on a map.

Once the order is placed, Sprint can normally get the installation completed within 60 days allowing for product shipment from the factory. If there are any other items I can help you with please contact me.

We verified the configurations at the various PSAP's to insure that all equipment upgrade requirements were defined.
