Pursuant to F.S. 192.102, the Lee County Tax Collector hereby requests the Board of County Commissioners approve an advance to the Tax Collector for Ad Valorem commission fees for Fiscal Year 2002-2003.

In as much as all Excess Fees are payable and due on the 31<sup>st</sup> day after the close of the fiscal year F.S. 218.36, the Tax Collector will require operating funds for the months of October and November 2002. The Ad Valorem commissions earned in Fiscal Year 2001-2002 approximates \$13.4 million, which averages out to \$1,116,000 per month. The two advances will be repaid once the Ad Valorem monies are collected and distributed.
