

GRANT AGREEMENT AMENDMENT

This Agreement is made this <u>September 30, 2002</u> day and between the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and <u>Lee County Board of County Commissioners</u> the Recipient.

RECITALS

- 1. HUD and Recipient entered into the Grant Agreement dated <u>October 3, 2001</u> for project number <u>FL14C003006</u> located in <u>Lee County, Florida</u>
- 2. Under the terms of the Grant Agreement, Recipient received a grant from HUD in the amount of \$192,120 to be used to carry out the project described in the Grant Agreement over a ve year period. The term of that Grant Agreement will end October 3, 2011
- 3. Recipient desires to make a change in the project [insert reasons here]. Change sponsor from Fort Myers Housing Authority to Renaissance Manor, Inc; a non-profit agency.
