LEE COUNTY RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING AND ESTABLISHING A BLASTING AD HOC ADVISORY COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the County Commission has determined that a study of blasting relating to land development is necessary; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of County Commissioners of Lee County to have a committee to assist with review of the blasting study; and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest and benefit to create such an advisory committee.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LEE COUNTY, FLORIDA THAT:

A Blasting Advisory Committee is hereby created by the Board of County Commissioners for review and assistance with the Blasting Study.

SECTION I. COMPOSITION AND TERMS OF OFFICE

A. <u>APPOINTMENT</u>

The Blasting Advisory Committee shall consist of ten (10) members, two appointed by each commissioner. Half the members shall represent the development industry, and half shall represent citizens.

All appointments shall require an affirmative vote of a majority of the Board of County Commissioners at a regularly scheduled meeting. Members shall serve without compensation.

B. <u>TERM OF OFFICE</u>

Committee members serve until the project is complete.

C. <u>REMOVAL</u>

A member of the Committee may be removed by an affirmative majority vote of the Board of County Commissioners at a regularly scheduled meeting or by the committee if the member misses 3 consecutive meetings.

D. <u>VACANCIES</u>

Vacancies on the Blasting Advisory Committee shall be filled by the County Commission according to the procedures as set out herein.

SECTION II. OFFICERS, RULES OF PROCEDURES, MEETINGS, VOTING AND RECORDS

A. <u>OFFICERS</u>

The Blasting Committee shall elect from its members a Chairman and a Vice-Chairman. The Chairman shall appoint, from the membership, one person to act as a Secretary.

B. RULES OF PROCEDURES

The Blasting Committee shall use Roberts Rules of Order and shall conduct all meetings pursuant to the provisions of all Resolutions, Regulations or Administrative Code provisions of the Board of County Commissioners.

C. <u>MEETINGS</u>

All meetings of the Blasting Committee shall be open to the public.

SECTION III. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The Blasting Committee shall have the following duties and responsibilities:

- a) Review the proposed options for blasting.
- b) Committee members shall have no financial or personal interest in the

outcome of any matter coming before such members in his/her official capacity.

- c) The Blasting Committee shall be strictly advisory in nature, and shall make no decisions with respect to any Lee County policies that concern or affect blasting.
- d) The Blasting Committee is subject to financial disclosure.

SECTION V. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Resolution shall become effective upon it adoption by the Board of County Commissioners of Lee County.
