Such services and/or work shall be known nominally as:

SECTION 1.00 SCOPE OF PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

CONSULTANT hereby agrees to provide and perform the professional services, tasks and work required and necessary to complete the services and work as set forth in Exhibit "SA-A," entitled "Scope of Professional Services" dated ________, 20____, which is attached hereto and made a part of this SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT.

SECTION 2.00 COMPENSATION

The AUTHORITY shall pay the CONSULTANT for all requested and authorized SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT services, tasks, or work completed hereunder by the CONSULTANT and accepted by the AUTHORITY in accordance with the provisions for compensation and payment of said services, tasks or work as set forth and prescribed in Exhibit "SA-B" dated ______, 20__, entitled "Compensation and Method Of Payment," which is attached hereto and made a part of this SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT.

The amount of the change in contract compensation and time set forth in this SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT is understood and agreed by both the AUTHORITY and the CONSULTANT to be fair, equitable and adequate, and the changed compensation is to include any and all direct costs, indirect costs, or associated costs which may result from or be caused by this SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT.

The CONSULTANT may cross-utilize funds from the various tasks to accomplish the overall purpose and goal of this AGREEMENT provided prior approval has been obtained from the PORT AUTHORITY. The PORT AUTHORITY shall review the need for such request and the impact on other assigned tasks.

The PORT AUTHORITY shall retain the authority to delete tasks, which are outlined in the scope of services.

SECTION 3.00 TIME AND SCHEDULE

3.01 Time is of the Essence

The timely performance and completion of the required services, work, and materials is vitally important to the interests of the AUTHORITY. Time is of the essence for all of the duties and obligations contained in this SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT.

3.02 Task Authorizations

Following the execution of this SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT, by both parties, the AUTHORITY shall issue the CONSULTANT a written Task Authorization. Following the issuance of such Task Authorization, the CONSULTANT shall be authorized to commence work and shall commence work promptly and shall carry on all such services, tasks and work as may be required in a continuous, diligent, and forthright manner to expeditious completion.

3.03 <u>Time of Performance</u>

The CONSULTANT agrees to complete the services, tasks or work required pursuant to this SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT, within the time period(s) for completion of the various phases and/or tasks of the project services set forth and described in Exhibit "SA-C," dated _______, 20____, entitled "Time and Schedule of Performance," which is attached hereto and made a part of this SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT.

SECTION 4.00 SUBCONSULTANT(S) AND SUBCONTRACTOR(S)

In providing and performing the services, tasks or work required pursuant to this SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT, the CONSULTANT intends to engage the assistance of the Subconsultant(s) and/or subcontractor(s) set forth in Exhibit "SA-D" dated ________, 20____, entitled "Consultant's Associated Subconsultant(s) and Subcontractor(s)," which is attached hereto and made a part of this SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT.

SECTION 5.00 PROJECT GUIDELINES AND CRITERIA

In providing and performing the tasks or work required pursuant to this SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT, the CONSULTANT shall be guided by the content of Exhibit "SA-E" dated _______, 20__, entitled "Project Guidelines and Criteria" which is attached hereto and made a part of this SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT.

SECTION 6.00 PROHIBITED INTERESTS

No member, officer or employee of the Port Authority or of the locality during his tenure or for one year thereafter shall have any interest, direct or indirect, in this Agreement or the proceeds thereof.

SECTION 7.00 LOBBYING CERTIFICATION

The CONSULTANT agrees that no Federal appropriated funds have been paid or will be paid by or on behalf of the CONSULTANT, to any person for influencing or attempting to influence any officer or employee of any Federal agency, a Member of Congress in connection with the awarding of any Federal contract, the making of any Federal grant, the making of any Federal loan, the entering into of any cooperative agreement, and the extension, continuation, renewal, amendment or modification of any Federal contract, grant, loan or cooperative agreement.

If any funds other than Federal appropriated funds have been paid by the CONSULTANT to any person for influencing or attempting to influence an officer or employee of any Federal agency, a Member of Congress, an officer or employee of Congress, or an employee of a Member of Congress in connection with this Agreement, the undersigned shall complete and submit Standard Form-LLL, "Disclosure Form to Report Lobbying," in accordance with its instructions.

The CONSULTANT shall require that the language of this section, as well as Section 6.00, be included in this award document for all subawards at all tiers (including subcontracts, subgrants, and contracts under grants, loans and cooperative agreements) and that all subrecipients shall certify and disclose accordingly.

Task 45 - RSW Cargo Road Improvements

I. OBJECTIVE

Obtain construction administration services (CA) for construction of the Cargo Road Improvements at the Southwest Florida International Airport. The Project includes the improvement of existing Cargo Road to the current standards for public access to include overlay, alignment and lighting. The project also includes construction of an airside roadway for airport related traffic and a connector from the maintenance facility to airside roadway, along with the installation of a fence and gates to provide security to the existing facilities on the north side of Cargo Road.

II. CONSTRUCTION ADMINISTRATION GENERAL SERVICES

- A. Attend the preconstruction conference.
- B. Review Contractor submittals, shop drawings and samples for conformance with the Contract Documents.
- C. Respond to questions regarding the design intent usually formalized as Requests for Information (RFIs).
- D. Attend weekly construction meetings and visit the site to resolve outstanding issues and observe the construction progress and general character and quality of the work. Also, visit the site during critical construction activities that the CA deems necessary to inspect and witness in order to provide certification at the end of the project.
- E. Review of the Contractor's monthly and final applications for payment and recommendation for acceptance or adjustments of payments in accordance with the contact documents.
- F. If requested, the CA shall participate in periodic Port Authority, Airports Special Management Committee, and Board of Port Commissioners meetings, as well as special meetings with Port Authority departments, CMR, and others to provide information and make recommendations concerning the project.
- G. Review and approve or disapprove any change orders and field directives as requested by the Port Authority. Also, review and approve or disapprove the results of all testing and Quality Assurance results.
- H. Provide technical assistance and expertise to the CMR and Port Authority during construction.

- I. Attend the substantial completion and final inspection(s), assist in preparing punch lists, and inspect work to confirm completion of punch list items.
- J. Provide original reproducible drawings to the CMR for them to reflect final as-built conditions on the drawings. The CA will review these as-built drawings.
- K. Provide final certification that the project was constructed in conformance with the contract documents and any project grant conditions. The final certifications/inspections shall include the Final Project Certification for FDOT as required.

III. FEE SUMMARY

The fee for the above scope of work is a lump sum amount distributed as follows:

Construction Administration Services \$50,000.00

The fee also includes, but is not limited to, reimbursement for trips, long distance telephone, postage, delivery, computer plots and printing. The fee includes all travel and project related expenses. Further, the fee includes all meetings necessary to effectively coordinate the project with governmental and permitting agencies.
