BACKGROUND: The Lutheran Church of the Good Shepard Incorporated, the owner of property located at 4000 Hancock Bridge Parkway and 1700 Golf Club Drive (STRAP Nos.: 09-44-24-00-01002.0190 & 16-44-24-03-03-0030C.0090), has requested the reconveyance of the County's interest in that portion of a 60-foot wide Viewer's Road created on May 16, 1952 and as set out in County Commission Minutes Book (CCMB) 11. Florida Statute §255.22 authorizes the County to reconvey property donated for a specific purpose if a request is received from an adjacent property owner and the County has not used the property for such purposes for a period of sixty (60) consecutive months. A review of the documents concerning this Viewer's Road indicates the statutory requirements for reconveyance have been met. County Staff recommends the Board approve the requested reconveyance. WITNESSETH: County, for and in consideration of the sum of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars to it in hand paid by the Grantee, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained and sold to the Grantee and its assigns forever, the County's interest in that portion of Viewer's Road as described in County Commission Minutes Book (CCMB) 11, Page 427, being more particularly described as follows:

In accordance with Florida Statutes s. 270.11, the County hereby reserves an undivided three-fourths interest in, and title in and to an undivided three-fourths interest in, all the phosphate, minerals, and metals that are or may be in, on, or under the subject land and an undivided one-half interest in all the petroleum that is or may be in, on, or under the subject land with the privilege to mine and develop each interest. Provided, however, the right of entry with respect to any interest in phosphate, minerals, metals or petroleum reserved in favor of the County is hereby released if the subject parcel being conveyed is or has always been a contiguous tract of less than 20 acres in the aggregate under the same ownership.

This grant conveys only the interest of the County and its Board of County Commissioners in the property herein described, and does not warrant the title or represent any state of facts concerning the title.





The Lutheran Church of the Good Shepard Incorporated –

Viewer's Road in Sections 9 and 16, Township 44, Range 24 East,

Lee County, Florida

The Department of Transportation has reviewed the documentation received from Attorney William Powell on behalf of the Lutheran Church. The subject property requested for reconveyance is an unbuilt 60 foot wide strip of land referenced in a 1952 County Commissioner Minutes Book 11, page 427. In accordance with Florida Statute 255.22, DOT acknowledges that no road was built on the land described, and DOT has not used this aforementioned viewer's description for any purpose for a period in excess of sixty (60) months. The property is located on the south side of Hancock Bridge Parkway but outside of the existing right-of-way of Hancock Bridge Parkway. DOT acknowledges that this description is an encumbrance on the existing strapped parcel for the Lutheran Church.

Based upon the review pursuant to Florida Statute 255.22, DOT concurs with the recommendation to reconvey the portion of the Viewer's Road described on the Ink Engineering sketch attached.
