1. REQUESTED MOTION:

ACTION REQUESTED: Approve award of Project # EX050049, the purchase of one new Versalift Model VST-5000I aerial device and chassis for DOT from Time Manufacturing Company at the prices given in the Federal General Services Administration Contract #GS-30F-1024H. Also approve the trade-in of asset # 019726 to Time Manufacturing for an amount of \$8000. Total cost: \$111,281.

WHY ACTION IS NECESSARY: As this expenditure will exceed \$50,000, Board approval is required.

WHAT ACTION ACCOMPLISHES: Provides DOT/Traffic with a new bucket truck to replace asset # 019726 which was damaged in a fire. The cost to repair the fire damage, together with other needed repairs, will exceed the value of the truck; therefore, it will be traded in on the new vehicle.
