On December 4, 2004 The Alliance of Bridgeless Islands of Lee County (ABI-Lee) held a Board of Directors Meeting. During this meeting, issues that affect the Bridgeless Islands were discussed at length.

Obviously, matters and concerns of great importance centered on the ability of residential and /or commercial property owners to realize long term ingress/egress through mainland Pine Island. As a result of development and zoning regulations many of the marina locations historically used by residents of Lee County and the Bridgeless Islands as access points have been placed under restricted use. It is recognized that restricted use may be necessary at certain waterfront locations; however Lee County Government's recognition for specific use at appropriate waterfront locations such as the Fisherman's Cooperative requires expansion in the form of municipal ownership in order to provide long term access. Over the past several years there have been many meetings and much discussion regarding this matter; however to date there are no long term solutions in place.

Taking into consideration the destruction in Pineland associated with the August 13, 2004 hurricane event, the problems associated with the movement of construction and debris from the Outer Islands in conjunction with the ever increasing requirement for water access by the residents of Lee County; it is obvious that Lee County Government reevaluate their position regarding a municipal mini-port.

The Board of Directors of the Alliance of Bridgeless Islands (ABI-Lee) request that the Greater Pine Island & Bridgeless Islands Citizens Liaison Committee forward this letter to the Lee County Commissioners in support that they move forward with the acquisition of appropriate properties that provide water access to the residents of Lee County.
