- 1. ACTION REQUESTED/PURPOSE: Waive a minor informality and award B-05-12 ESTERO PARKWAY AND IRRIGATION to the second lowest responsive, responsible bidder, Big Tree, Inc., for a total not-to-exceed Base Bid amount of \$452,507.60, plus Alternates A, B and C in a total not-to-exceed amount of \$23,121.20, for a project total of \$475,628.80, with a final project completion time of 455 calendar days. This project was anticipated and funds are available within the budget.
- 2. WHAT ACTION ACCOMPLISHES: Provides Lee County with a Contractor for the installation of plant material and underground irrigation system, including wells, pumps, electrical, directional boring and landscape and irrigation maintenance.
- 3. MANAGEMENT RECOMMENDATION: Approval Recommended.

9. Background:

The Department of Transportation submitted a request to Contracts Management to obtain bids for the Estero Parkway Landscape and Irrigation project. The expected cost of the project required the use of the formal sealed bid procedure.

On the bidding deadline of February 23, 2005, Contracts received three (3) bids. Upon initial review of all bids, the apparent low bidder was J.W. Conner & Sons, Inc. However, Lee County Contracts was informed on April 29, 2005 that the company was involved in negotiations to finalize the sale of J.W. Conner Inc. to APAC-Southeast, Inc. Lee County bid documents state that a bidder may not assign or otherwise transfer its bid prior to or after the bid opening time; therefore the contract could not be awarded to the low bidder. Lee County received a recommendation from the project's consultant, Johnson Engineering, recommending the third low bidder, Vila & Sons Landscaping Corp. However, after further review, staff recommends the board waive a minor informality and award the bid to the second low bidder, Big Tree, Inc. (a local bidder).

Re: Johnson Engineering, Inc.'s Landscape and Irrigation Contractor Recommendation for the Estero Parkway Landscape and Irrigation Project from US 41 to Three Oaks Parkway

Pat,

Upon review of the three lowest bid contractors for the Estero Parkway Landscape and Irrigation Project from US 41 to Three Oaks Parkway, Johnson Engineering, Inc.'s findings are as follows:

J.W. Connor & Sons, Inc. (lowest bidder)

- 1. Constructions Operations: minimally adequate to complete the job. They had two positive references and two negative references. The negative references included an individual (wishing to stay anonymous) who is employed by FDOT in the Gainesville District Office. The company uses unskilled day labor to install the jobs. This results in quality inconsistency and unqualified personnel on site when supervision is not present. This is not accordance with Sec. 3.1.05 of the Project Manual for Estero Parkway Landscape and Irrigation Project from US 41 to Three Oaks Parkway requiring qualified, competent, English speaking representatives during all working hours.
- 2. **Quality Control:** materials may or may not meet specifications (based on two sources). The two positive construction recommendations were for projects that they did not maintain after installation. Several occasions there materials did not meet standards and required FDOT to spend numerous hours of inspection time on projects. The higher the quality of plant materials increases its success rate according to the International Society of Arboriculture.
- 3. Maintenance and Warranty: inadequate in all aspects in maintaining and replacing warranty issues (based on two sources). Contractor told FDOT that they do not bid maintenance and warranty items in their price to get the job. They rely on "mother nature" and "rolling the dice" according to the contractor. The do not remove weeds, and have caused projects to fail due to maintenance issues.

Vila & Son Landscaping Corporation (Second Lowest Bidder)

- 1. Constructions Operations: High quality work in a timely manner. All references would use company again. Said by many to be the best they have worked with on similar projects.
- 2. Quality Control: No issues. All projects met or exceeded client expectations.
- 3. **Maintenance and Warranty:** Projects properly maintained and warranty items replaced in an acceptable timeframe.

Big Tree, Inc (Third lowest bidder)

1. Qualification questionnaire is incomplete and does not contain enough information for consideration for this project.

Johnson Engineering, Inc.'s Recommendation:

The lowest bidder, J. W. Connor and Sons, Inc. has failed to demonstrate that they will be able to perform the scope of this project according to the project manual. Their bid is suspiciously low comparable (\$70,000.00+/- less) to the other two lowest bids (within \$700.00 of each other). This confirms the statement for FDOT that they do not bid in maintenance and replacement contingency. Using this contractor would require that LCDOT hires a construction manager to ensure that the contract is being fulfilled. This additional expense would most probably negate any savings.

We recommend that LCDOT utilize the services of Vila and Son Landscaping Corporation, the second lowest bidder. The quality of workmanship, materials, and maintenance are impeccable from their past project performance. Their bid is in line with the other contractors and seems to be a valid one. We feel that Vila and Son Landscaping Corporation is the <u>lowest qualified</u> bidder.

Johnson Engineering, Inc. hopes that our recommendation assists LCDOT in their choice of a contractor for the Estero Parkway Landscape and Irrigation Project from US 41 to Three Oaks Parkway.
