WHEREAS, the PARTIES acknowledge that this cooperative joint exercise of power enables them to provide advanced services to the benefit of their jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the residents and property owners of the District and County to have this equipment at the disposal of the CITY; and

WHEREAS, the Lee County Board of County Commissioners authorized Emergency Medical Service (EMS) to purchase and distribute computer hardware and software to the Advanced Life Support (ALS) fire districts in Lee County; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the residents of the CITY and COUNTY to distribute this computer hardware and software to the ALS fire districts; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties agree to the following terms and conditions

hereinafter set forth, the CITY and the COUNTY, intending to be legally bound, hereby agree as follows:

- 1. The Recitals as set forth above are incorporated into the terms of this Agreement as if set out herein at length.
- 2. The CITY represents to the COUNTY that the execution and delivery of this Interlocal Agreement has been duly authorized by all appropriate actions of the governing body of the CITY, has been executed and delivered by an authorized officer of the CITY, and constitutes a legal, valid and binding obligation of the CITY. The COUNTY represents to the CITY that the execution and delivery of this Interlocal Agreement has been duly authorized by all appropriate actions of the governing body of the COUNTY, has been executed and delivered by an authorized officer of the COUNTY, and constitutes a legal, valid and binding obligation of the COUNTY.
- This Interlocal Agreement shall commence on execution by the COUNTY.
- 4. The Motorola equipment purchased by the COUNTY will be placed in CITY'S ALS response vehicles (see Exhibit "A").

- 9. The Parties agree that by execution of this Interlocal Agreement, no party will be deemed to have waived its statutory defense of sovereign immunity or increased its limits of liability as provided for by Florida Statutes.
- 10. This Interlocal Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida.
- 11. No assignment, delegation, transfer or novation of this Interlocal Agreement or any part thereof shall be made, unless approved in writing by the CITY and the COUNTY.
- 12. Nothing in this agreement should be construed to create any rights in third parties.

The COUNTY represents to the DISTRICT that the execution and delivery of this Interlocal Agreement has been duly authorized by all appropriate actions of the governing body of the COUNTY, has been executed and delivered by an authorized officer of the COUNTY, and constitutes a legal, valid and binding obligation of the COUNTY.
- This Interlocal Agreement shall commence on execution by the COUNTY.
- 4. The Motorola equipment purchased by the COUNTY will be placed in the DISTRICTS ALS response vehicles (see Exhibit "A").
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- The DISTRICT will appoint a person to act as PMDC System Administrator and liaison to the COUNTY'S Telecommunications Program. The DISTRICT will be responsible for training its personnel and installing its own updates to its PMDC laptops.

The COUNTY'S Telecommunications Program's CAD System Administrator will provide technical support as needed, but only in regards to the PMDC and the Advance Tactical Mapping Mobile products

- 8. Upon installation of the equipment, the County shall execute all documents necessary to transfer ownership to the District.
- 9. The Parties agree that by execution of this Interlocal Agreement, no party will be deemed to have waived its statutory defense of sovereign immunity or increased its limits of liability as provided for by Florida Statutes.
- 10. This Interlocal Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida.
- 11. No assignment, delegation, transfer or novation of this Interlocal Agreement or any part thereof shall be made, unless approved in writing by the DISTRICT and the COUNTY.
