9. Background:

Letters of Interest were solicited on behalf of the Board of County Commissioners for professional services for the project known as CN-05-13 Miscellaneous Plumbing, HVAC & Electrical Services for Lee County.

The deadline for receipt of Letters of Interest was June 27, 2005. A total of six (6) letters of Interest were received by the established deadline. The Competitive Negotiations Committee consisted of the following staff members: Jim Lavender, Public Works Director, Chairperson, Peter Wisniewski, Construction & Design & Rich Beck, Facilities Management. On the basis of the information submitted by the six (6) firms in their Letters of Interest, it was the consensus of the committee to invite four (4) firms for telephone interviews: Anchor Engineering Consultants, Inc; Burgess Engineering, Inc.; MEP Associates, Inc. & TLC Engineering for Architecture.

On the basis of the information submitted by the firms in their Letters of Interest and after conducting the telephone interviews on July 27, 2005, with the "short list" firms, it was the consensus of the Committee to recommend to the Board the selection of all four (4) firms and request Board approval for staff to commence contract negotiations with the four (4) firms as follows: Anchor Engineering Consultants, Inc; Burgess Engineering, Inc.; MEP Associates, Inc. & TLC Engineering for Architecture; for a contract period of two (2) years with the option of renewal for one (1) additional twelve (12) month period.

Funds will be available within specific project budgets.
