the Lee County Homeless Coalition will sponsor several events during Lee County Homeless Week to promote awareness in the community; and

on November 19, 2005 the "Homeless Persons Service Day and Veterans Stand Down" will offer employment opportunities, medical, psychological, addictions intervention, veterans services, spiritual counseling, clothing, food and other resources services at the All Soul's Episcopal Church in North Fort Myers.
