- 1. ACTION REQUESTED/PURPOSE: Adopt Resolutions with the following amendments:
- A). Increase the maximum assistance awards for Homeownership Construction in the 2005-2006 Hurricane Housing Recovery Program Plan.
- B). Require that in their tenant selection process, rental projects assisted with recovery funds give priority to disaster victims for 15 years. Requirement to be added to the 2002/03 - 2004/05 and 2005/06 - 2007/08 SHIP (State Housing Initiatives Partnership) Plans and the 2005-2006 Hurricane Housing Recovery Program Plan.
- C). Authorize the County Manager to make minor revisions that may be required for final state approval.

Approval of these amendments would allow adaptation to current economic conditions.

9. Background:

Proposed amendments

- A. <u>Increase the maximum awards for homeownership in the 2005/06 Hurricane Housing Recovery Program Plan</u> from \$50,000 to \$70,000 for very-low income and from \$40,000 to \$60,000 for low-income households (see attached). This increase is needed to meet increasing labor and material costs. This increase will enable housing providers to help mainly elderly and disabled victims whose homes were destroyed by the hurricanes to rebuild on the lots owned by the victims.
- B. Require that in their tenant selection process rental projects assisted with recovery funds give priority to disaster victims for 15 years (which is the standard monitoring period). Requirement to be added to the 2002/3 -2004/5 and 2005/06 - 2007/08 SHIP (State Housing Initiatives Partnership) Plans and the 2005-2006 Hurricane Housing Recovery Program Plans. Currently rental projects receiving hurricane assistance funds are required to provide priority to disaster victims only during initial lease-up. By extending this requirement, disaster recovery personnel improve their effectiveness because they will have at their disposal a pool of rental units which give priority to hurricane victims. Also if more units receive disaster assistance funds in the future, the total number of developments giving priority to hurricane victims will increase and as a result, minimize the impact on each individual development.

To qualify, applicant households must be eligible under the HHR income guidelines and select housing that meets criteria in Sec. 420.907 Florida Statutes and Chapter 67-37 Florida Administrative Code. New construction or rehabilitation by non-profit sponsors or governmental agencies is made available on a first come, first ready, most needed basis to households that have been impacted by the hurricanes. In their rental selection process, rental projects that receive disaster assistance funds shall give priority to households impacted by disasters for 15 years.
