homeless census completed in January 2006 documented 318 chronic
homeless, 429 severely mentally ill, 919 chronic substance abusers,
216 veterans, 42 persons with HIVAIDS, 117 victims of domestic
violence, and 145 children under the age of 18; and

- Whereas: On November 18, 2006 the "Homeless Persons Service Day and Veterans Stand Down" will offer employment opportunities, medical, psychological, addictions intervention, veterans services, spiritual counseling, clothing, food and other services at Community Cooperative Ministries, Inc., "The Soup Kitchen", in Fort Myers.
