Chapter 137
BONDS OF COUNTY
OFFICERS

137.05 Duty of boards of county commissioners.—The board of county commissioners of each county shall at its regular meetings in January and June of each year examine carefully as to the sufficiency of bonds of the county officers, and if it has reason to believe that the sufficiency of any bond has become impaired, it must at once require the officer to execute and file with the proper officer a new bond for the same amount and under the same conditions as his or her former bond.

### LEE COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 00-25

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING LEE COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 98-22; AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO LEE COUNTY OFFICERS AND BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS; RELATING TO FAITHFUL PERFORMANCE AND DISCHARGE OF DUTIES; PROVIDING FOR FAITHFUL PERFORMANCE BONDS; PROVIDING AN AMENDMENT TO ADD BONDS FOR COUNTY CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICERS AND REQUIREMENTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY CONFLICT AND EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Lee County has adopted Lee County Ordinance No. 98-22 requiring those County Officers and members of the Board of County Commissioners as designated therein to give bonds conditioned for the faithful performance of the duties of his or her office; and

WHEREAS, Lee County Ordinance 98-22 provided that only County Commissioners provide said bonds: and

WHEREAS, the existing faithful performance bonds of County Constitutional Officers expire upon the conclusion of their present term of office; and

WHEREAS, an amendment of Lee County Ordinance 98-22 is required to provide that the County Constitutional Officers have faithful performance bonds at their existing principal amounts upon expiration of their present bonds.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
OF LEE COUNTY, FLORIDA THAT:

### SECTION ONE.

The intent of this amendatory ordinance is to add the County Constitutional Officers to the Lee County Ordinance 98-22 requirements and provisions of providing bond conditioned for the faithful performance of the duties of their respective office.

### SECTION TWO.

Lee County Ordinance 98-22 Section 1 is hereby amended as follows with new language shown by underlining as set forth in Section Three hereof.

#### SECTION THREE.

Section 1 of Lee County Ordinance 98-22 is hereby amended to read as follows:

### Section 1

The Board of County Commissioners of Lee County hereby requires those County Officers, and each respective County Commissioner as provided herein to give a bond conditioned for the faithful performance and discharge of the duties of his or her office. Said bond to be to the Governor of the State and the Governor=s successors in office. The principal amount of the bond shall be as stated herein and as set forth below for each respective office or officer designated. The principal amount of each bond is provided in consideration of the amount of money or property likely to be collected and/or in the custody of the County Commissioner at any one time. The office/officer and bond amount to be:

Office/Officer	Principal Amount of Bond			
County Commissioner	\$ 2,000.00			
Clerk of Courts	<u>\$100,000.00</u>			
Property Appraiser	<u>\$ 25,000.00</u>			
Sheriff	\$ 10,000.00			
Supervisor of Elections	\$ 5,000.00			
Tax Collector	<u>\$ 15,000.00</u>			

### SECTION FOUR. INCLUSION IN CODE.

It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of this ordinance shall become and be made a part of Lee County Code; and that the sections of this ordinance may be renumbered or relettered and the word "Ordinance" may be changed to "Section", "Article", or such other appropriate word or phrase in order to accomplish such intentions.

### SECTION FIVE. CONFLICTS.

Whenever the requirements or provisions of this ordinance are in conflict with the requirements or provisions of any other lawfully adopted ordinance or statute, the most restrictive requirements shall apply.

### SECTION SIX. SEVERABILITY.

The provisions of this ordinance are severable, and it is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners of Lee County, Florida to confer the whole or any part of the powers herein provided. If any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be held unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, the decision of such court shall not affect or impair the remaining provisions of this ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent of the Board of County Commissioners that this ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional provision not been included herein.

### SECTION SEVEN. <u>EFFECTIVE DATE</u>.

This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon receipt of official acknowledgment from the office of the Secretary of State of Florida that the ordinance has been filed.
