9. Background: Lee County has updated its local mitigation strategy that was initially adopted January 4, 2000 by Resolution No. 00-01-01. The reasons for the update are to incorporate hazard mitigation policy gained from disaster experiences occurring since the initial adoption date, to comply with recent federal legislation requiring strategies to meet certain criteria in order to be eligible for federal hazard mitigation grant dollars, and to take advantage of more scientific and technically based risk assessment tools to determine the threats of hazards to Lee County and its municipalities. The public hearing requirement was not a mandatory condition when the initial local mitigation strategy adoption took place.

The Lee County Disaster Advisory Council served as the working group to develop the strategy with assistance and guidance from the community's municipalities.

A RESOLUTION OF THE LEE COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 00-01-01 WHICH ESTABLISHED THE INITIAL EDITION OF THE UNIFIED LOCAL MITIGATION STRATEGY; AND ADOPTING THE UPDATED UNIFIED LOCAL MITIGATION STRATEGY FOR LEE COUNTY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners is the governing body in and for Lee County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners previously adopted Resolution
No. 00-01-01 on January 4, 2000, establishing the initial edition of the Unified Local
Mitigation Strategy for Lee County; and

WHEREAS, Lee County and its municipalities are vulnerable to several natural and human caused hazards including hurricanes, tornadoes, floods, fires, coastal erosion, drought, extreme temperatures, exotic pests and chemical releases, and face potential damage to life, property, natural resources and the local economy; and

WHEREAS, The Local Mitigation Strategy Working Groups consist of employees and community members from Lee County, the City of Bonita Springs, the City of Cape Coral, the City of Fort Myers, the Town of Fort Myers Beach, and the City of Sanibel, and is open for participation to any and all interested parties; and

WHEREAS, the Working Group has identified these local hazards and reassessed the county-wide vulnerability and risk to these hazards based on the latest scientific and technically based risk assessment techniques; and

WHEREAS the Unified Local Mitigation Strategy has been updated to reflect the knowledge gained from disasters that Lee County has experienced over the past six years; and

WHEREAS the Unified Local Mitigation Strategy has been restructured to serve as the County's Floodplain Management Plan in accordance with Policy 110.1.5 of the Lee Plan: and

WHEREAS, projects identified in the Local Mitigation Strategy Mitigation
Initiatives List are given more consideration by federal and state-managed funding
programs such as the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program, the Flood Mitigation
Assistance Program, Emergency Management Preparedness Assistance Trust Fund,
Communities Trust, Community Development Block Grant, Coastal Partnerships
Initiative, and HOME; and

WHEREAS, the Local Mitigation Strategy can supplement the County's Post-Disaster Redevelopment Plan as required of all coastal counties in Florida by Florida Administrative Code Rule 9J-5 as part of the Comprehensive Growth Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Local Mitigation Strategy is designed to be a process oriented document with review and revision policies that allow it to be changed to meet new or changing conditions including hazard-event frequency, perceived local needs and funding opportunities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

- 1. The above recitals are hereby incorporated herein as if set forth at length.
- The Unified Local Mitigation Strategy for Lee County to serve as a policy document to guide and govern Lee County's hazard mitigation activities is adopted.
- 3. Lee County Resolution No. 00-01-01 is hereby repealed.
