RESOLUTION

Human rights are protected by the law of the land and must be respected by all; and, human trafficking, or modern day slavery, is an inhuman and evil violation of human rights; and,

Whereas:

Human trafficking is a 17 plus billion dollar a year business, second to drug smuggling, with twenty seven million human trafficking victims around the world – of which over two million victims are in the United States of America. Florida is the number two destination point in the nation for potential victims of human trafficking; and,

Whereas:

The State of Florida and local governments encourage the efforts of local agencies and organizations who protect against the violations of human rights, especially victims of human trafficking; and,

Whereas:

In Lee County, the Florida Coalition Against Human Trafficking, Lee County Sheriff's Office and the Lee County Human Trafficking Task Force have lead the outreach and have assisted rescuing victims of human trafficking; and,

Whereas:

The Florida Coalition Against Human Trafficking, the Lee County Sheriff's Office and the Lee County Human Trafficking Task Force have been publicly recognized by the federal agencies for their continued support, which has led to the arrest and prosecution of traffickers and violators of human rights, and most importantly, the rescue of victims in Southwest Florida; and,


Whereas:
