increased recognition and understanding to ensure that individuals with autism are accurately diagnosed and appropriately treated throughout

their lives; and

Whereas: It is in our interest as a community to recognize achievements in this field

and to continue these efforts by promoting awareness and fostering the

understanding of autism.
