10. Background:

Letters of Interest were solicited on behalf of the Board of County Commissioners for professional services for the State Road 82 Dual Lefts At Daniels Parkway/Gunnery Road Intersection project.

The deadline for receipt of Letters of Interest was March 21, 2007. A total of eight (8) Letters of Interest were submitted by the established deadline. All eight (8) Letters of Interest were considered at the Competitive Negotiations Committee meeting on April 5, 2007. The Competitive Negotiations Committee consisted of: Jim Lavender, Public Works Director, Chairman, Scott Gilbertson, Director, Lee County DOT and Nicole Maxey, DOT, Project Manager. Based on the information submitted by all eight (8) firms, it was the consensus of the Committee to invite five (5) firms for telephone interviews.

On the basis of the information submitted by the firms in the Letters of Interest and after conducting telephone interviews, the Committee agreed to recommend to the Board the following order of ranking of Consultants: 1) AIM Engineering & Surveying, Inc.; 2) David Douglas Associates, Inc.; 3) Hole Montes; 4) Dyer, Riddle, Mills & Precourt, Inc.; and 5) Johnson Engineering.

The negotiated agreement will be brought back to the Board for approval.
