  - 3. Board of Port Commissioners Discussion and Motions
  - 4. Adoption of FY12-13 Final Port Authority Budget Resolution with any appropriate changes.
- b) Following that, the Board will reconvene as the Board of County Commissioners and will proceed as follows:
  - 1. Presentation of Lee County's Total Budget by Assistant County Manager/Acting Budget Director.
  - 2. Public Comment for all budget issues under the authority of the Board of County Commissioners. This will be your only opportunity to comment on all budgets the Board of County Commissioners has authority over. There will be no other opportunity during this hearing to provide your comments.
  - 3. Consider Special Taxing Units Final Millages and Budgets for each of the above-stated Board of County Commissioners' millages and budgets. The Board of County Commissioners may comment and then take action to move for approval of (a) appropriate changes, (b) a resolution to adopt the Final Millage, and (c) the Final Budget
  - 4. Consider Countywide Final Millage and Budget.
  - 5. Consider Library, Unincorporated MSTU, and All Hazard Protection Final Millages and Budgets.
  - 6. Consider "All Other" Final Budgets.
