



On June 20, 2018 at 9:00 a.m. a meeting was held at the Public Works building regarding road paving change to the Cherry Estates Side Street. Notice per attached email.

Change for Harpoon Lane use 1.5" Type B 12.5 black base in lieu of stabilized subgrade, and 4" Type B 12.5 black base (5.5" total). Monitoring of vibrations will be visually conducted by PMI on a daily basis.

For normal crowned streets mill and repave with one-inch thickness of asphalt. Each driveway currently is either above or below the roadway and will be the same with the new paving. The approach will provide the roadway to be as smooth as possible and would allow the asphalt yield of 1". Contractor will hand rake as necessary at the driveways to try to create a smooth transition. No reveal requirements at the driveways will be guaranteed.

Noted that with repaving of streets rain will no longer be exiting the streets through cracks and therefore may result in some puddling in areas.
