Conservation 20/20 primary use preserves and some limited use preserves open to public access following Hurricane Irma

All Conservation 20/20 primary preserves are now open for public access following Hurricane Irma. These locations include:

- Prairie Pines Preserve
- Caloosahatchee Creeks Preserve
- Galt Preserve
- Wild Turkey Strand Preserve
- San Carlos Bay – Bunche Beach Preserve

Some limited use preserves are also open for public access. As of Monday, October 9, these locations include:

- Daniels Preserve at Spanish Creek
- Hickory Swamp Preserve
- Hidden Cypress Preserve
- Pine Island Flatwoods Preserve
- Pop Ash Creek Preserve
- Powell Creek Preserve
