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**Lee County Community Development April 2016 Permit Report**

Fort Myers, Fla., May 2, 2016 — During April, contractors pulled 93 permits to build single-family houses collectively valued at about \$25.5 million in unincorporated Lee County. That compares to 100 permits issued in March 2016 and 136 issued in April 2015, according to the Lee County Department of Community Development. Data for 2015 includes permits for the Village of Estero.

Also during April, 28 multi-family units valued at about \$2.4 million were permitted, compared to six units in March and eight units in April 2015.

General commercial activity was valued at about \$1.7 million for 18 permits, compared to about \$8.1 million in March and about \$1.8 million in April 2015.

Lee County Community Development issued 3,850 permits of all kinds in April.

Lee County Community Development oversees planning, zoning, development and building services, environmental review, building inspection and code enforcement for the unincorporated areas of Lee County.
