Lee County Community Development February 2016 Permit Report

Fort Myers, Fla., March 1, 2016 — During February, contractors pulled 84 permits to build single-family houses collectively valued at more than \$17 million in unincorporated Lee County. That compares to 107 permits issued in January 2016 and 101 issued in February 2015, according to the Lee County Department of Community Development. Data for 2015 includes permits for the Village of Estero.

Also during February, 27 multi-family units valued at about \$4 million were permitted, compared to 14 units in January and 74 units in February 2015.

General commercial activity was valued at about \$6.2 million for 18 permits, compared to about \$8.8 million in January and about \$45.9 million in February 2015.

Lee County Community Development issued 3,576 permits of all kinds in February.

Lee County Community Development oversees planning, zoning, development and building services, environmental review, building inspection and code enforcement for the unincorporated areas of Lee County.
