Lee County Community Development January 2016 Permit Report

Fort Myers, Fla., Feb. 1, 2016 — During January, contractors pulled 107 permits to build single-family houses collectively valued at more than \$20.3 million in unincorporated Lee County. That compares to 132 permits issued in December 2015 and 79 issued in January 2015, according to the Lee County Department of Community Development. Data for 2015 includes permits for the Village of Estero.

Also during January, 14 multi-family units valued at about \$1 million, were permitted, compared to 200 units in December and 358 in January 2015.

General commercial activity was valued at about \$8.8 million for 19 permits, compared to about \$3.7 million in December and about \$26 million in January 2015.

Lee County Community Development issued 3,396 permits of all kinds in January.

Lee County Community Development oversees planning, zoning, development and building services, environmental review, building inspection and code enforcement for the unincorporated areas of Lee County.
