Lee County Community Development July 2016 Permit Report

Fort Myers, Fla., Aug. 1, 2016 — During July, contractors pulled 90 permits to build single-family houses collectively valued at about \$19.4 million in unincorporated Lee County. That compares to 116 permits issued in June 2016 and 94 issued in July 2015, according to the Lee County Department of Community Development. Data for 2015 includes permits for the Village of Estero.

Also during July, eight multi-family units valued at about \$815,000 were permitted, compared to 93 units in June 2016 and 64 units in July 2015.

General commercial activity was valued at about \$333,000 for eight permits, compared to about \$22.3 million in June 2016 and about \$1.7 million in July 2015.

Lee County Community Development issued 3,484 permits of all kinds in July.

Lee County Community Development oversees planning, zoning, development and building services, environmental review, building inspection, and code enforcement for the unincorporated areas of Lee County.
