Lee County Community Development May 2016 Permit Report

Fort Myers, Fla., June 1, 2016 — During May, contractors pulled 98 permits to build single-family houses collectively valued at about \$22 million in unincorporated Lee County. That compares to 93 permits issued in April 2016 and 90 issued in May 2015, according to the Lee County Department of Community Development. Data for 2015 includes permits for the Village of Estero.

Also during May, 26 multi-family units valued at about \$3.4 million were permitted, compared to 28 units in April and 51 units in May 2015.

General commercial activity was valued at about \$2.1 million for 15 permits, compared to about \$1.7 million in April and about \$15.3 million in May 2015.

Lee County Community Development issued 3,959 permits of all kinds in May.

Lee County Community Development oversees planning, zoning, development and building services, environmental review, building inspection and code enforcement for the unincorporated areas of Lee County.
