Lee County Community Development September 2016 Permit Report

Fort Myers, Fla., Oct. 3, 2016 — During September, contractors pulled 127 permits to build single-family houses collectively valued at about \$26.3 million in unincorporated Lee County. That compares to 111 permits issued in August 2016 and 118 issued in September 2015, according to the Lee County Department of Community Development. Data for 2015 includes permits for the Village of Estero.

Also during September, 41 multi-family units valued at about \$4.1 million were permitted, compared to 52 units in August and 722 units in September 2015.

General commercial activity was valued at about \$16 million for 16 permits, compared to about \$18.8 million in August and about \$50.8 million in September 2015.

Lee County Community Development issued 3,700 permits of all kinds in September.

Lee County Community Development oversees planning, zoning, development and building services, environmental review, building inspection, and code enforcement for the unincorporated areas of Lee County.
