Lee County Community Development January 2017 Permit Report

Fort Myers, Fla., Feb. 3, 2017 — During January, contractors pulled 134 permits to build single-family houses collectively valued at about \$29.5 million in unincorporated Lee County. That compares to 85 permits issued in December 2016 and 107 issued in January 2016, according to the Lee County Department of Community Development.

Also during January, six multi-family units valued at about \$768,000 were permitted, compared to 12 units in December 2016 and 14 units in January 2016.

General commercial activity was valued at about \$9.6 million for 33 permits, compared to about \$4.1 million in December 2016 and about \$8.8 million in January 2016.

Lee County Community Development issued 3,920 permits of all kinds in January.

Lee County Community Development oversees planning, zoning, development and building services, environmental review, building inspection, and code enforcement for the unincorporated areas of Lee County.
