Lee County Homeless Continuum of Care Awarded \$1,762,276 in Program Funds

Fort Myers, FL, May 16, 2016 — The Lee County Homeless Continuum of Care, which includes local government, non-profit, and faith-based organizations, has been awarded \$1,762,276 in federal funding to provide housing and services for Lee County residents who are homeless. Eight programs are existing programs receiving renewal grant awards.

SalusCare, Inc., will receive renewal funding for a rental subsidy program, and two permanent housing programs.

Community Assisted and Supported Living, Inc. will receive renewal funding for two rental subsidy programs and two permanent housing programs.

The Salvation Army will receive renewal funding for rapid rehousing, which will permanently house eligible families.

The 2015 awards total over \$1.9 billion nationwide. Funding for local Continuums of Care is provided by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and is awarded following a national competitive application process.
