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**ROAD WATCH UPDATE**  
**February 15 – February 21, 2018**

**Alva Drawbridge:** Lee County DOT will perform drawbridge maintenance on the Alva Drawbridge starting March 1<sup>st</sup> at 9 p.m. and finish March 2, 2018 at 2 a.m. During this time, there will be drawbridge openings in 15 to 20 minute increments as part of the maintenance work. **Bonita Beach Road SE:** Century Link will be working on a manhole system just east of 9491 Bonita Beach Road SE on February 15, 2018 from 7 p.m. to midnight. Motorist should use caution, as the eastbound right lane will be closed. For further information, please call Nathan Glenn at 239-231-7150.

**Cape Coral Parkway & Santa Barbara Boulevard:** Lee County DOT will perform traffic signal/overhead repairs at Cape Coral Parkway and Santa Barbara Boulevard on February 15, 2018 between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. Motorists should use caution, as there will be periodic lane closures. **Colonial Boulevard/Midpoint Memorial Bridge - Street Lighting Work:** Lee County DOT will replace a streetlight on Colonial Boulevard just east of the Midpoint Bridge (McGregor overpass) on Saturday, February 17, 2018. Motorists are encouraged to use caution, as there will be intermittent lane closures between Summerlin and McGregor from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. For further information, please call Mike Padgett at 239-533-9500.

**Lee County RWA – Week of February 19, 2018**

**Estero Boulevard Construction – reFRESH Estero Boulevard/Waterlines – Lovers Lane to Albatross Street.**

Contractors for Fort Myers Beach and Lee County are installing new water main, and sanitary sewer force main, storm drainage, sidewalk and rebuilding roadway on Estero Boulevard from Lovers Lane to Albatross Street. **Motorists may experience daytime and nighttime intermittent one-lane traffic on Estero Boulevard. Flaggers will alternate traffic frequently, but motorists should expect delays.** Crews are expected to work Monday through Friday and most Saturdays.

**Segment 2 - Lovers Lane to Madera Road:**

Lovers Lane to Strandview Avenue – Northbound traffic is shifted to the center lane while crews work on the bay side of Estero Boulevard.

**Segment 3 and 4 – Strandview Avenue to Albatross Street:**

Strandview Avenue to Aberdeen Avenue – Northbound traffic is shifted to the center lane while crews install sanitary sewer force main on the bay side of Estero Boulevard.

Beginning Monday, February 19, contractors for Lee County will locate underground utilities using soft dig excavating on Estero Boulevard at the following side streets:

**Page Park Water Main Replacement – Phase 1**

**Updated February 14, 2018**

Lee County Utilities – Page Park Water Main Replacement Phase I from Danley Drive/Airport Road at 6<sup>th</sup> Street east to Metro Parkway and north to Idlewild Street.

Contractors for Lee County Utilities continue water main improvements for the Page Park neighborhood. Installation of the water main will start at Idlewild Street. Crews will progress south on the east side of Metro Parkway, bore under Metro Parkway to the west side and continue south on Metro Parkway to the north side of Danley Drive then west to 6<sup>th</sup> Street. Some driveways will be temporarily closed but businesses and residences will have access throughout the project. Some sidewalks may be closed during the project. This schedule may be subject to change due to inclement weather and unforeseen underground conditions. Crews are working near the roadway. Drivers and pedestrians should use caution. **Striping Maintenance:** Lee County DOT will be performing a moving operation with traffic delays on **2-15-18 through 2-21-18** between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. (weather permitting) on the following roadways:

## 1. Road Work/Maintenance/Improvements:

Burnt Store Road from Diplomat Parkway to Van Buren Parkway: Construction Project: This project consists of the initial widening of Burnt Store Road to four lanes (ultimately the future design is for six lanes with a two-lane frontage road). The project also includes installation of conduits under the road for the City of Cape Coral. Motorists should expect intermittent northbound and southbound lane closures during nighttime/overnight hours, weather permitting.

- Van Buren Parkway at the intersection of Burnt Store Road: Northbound and southbound Burnt Store Road motorists must use the new connecting ramp just

north of Van Buren Parkway to access Van Buren Parkway. Westbound Van Buren Parkway motorists must also use this ramp to access Burnt Store Road.

- Diplomat Parkway at the intersection of Burnt Store Road: Northbound and southbound Burnt Store Road motorists must use the new connecting ramp at NW 12th Terrace to access Diplomat Parkway. Westbound Diplomat Parkway motorists must also use this ramp to access Burnt Store Road.
- NW 14th Terrace at the intersection of Burnt Store Road: This intersection is PERMANENTLY CLOSED. Motorists should access NW 14th Terrace via NW 16th Street.
- NW 17th Lane at the intersection of Burnt Store Road: This intersection is PERMANENTLY CLOSED. Motorists should now use NW 16th Street to access the neighborhood.
- NW 19th Terrace from Burnt Store Road to NW 31st Place is PERMANENTLY CLOSED. Motorists should now use NW 18th Terrace to access the neighborhood.

This north segment from Diplomat Parkway to Van Buren Parkway costs \$15.3 million and the City of Cape Coral's utility conduits are \$550,000. The contractor is Quality Enterprises, USA, Inc. **Daniels Parkway & Six Mile Cypress:** Clarke Construction will perform roadwork on Daniels Parkway just west of Six Mile Cypress Parkway by adding a new westbound turn lane into Daniel's Market Place starting **February 11 through February 21, 2018**. Other work will include repaving and striping of Brookshire to include a southbound turn lane extension. Motorists should use caution, as there will be nighttime lane closures during construction between 7 p.m. and 6 a.m. Message boards will be in place alerting motorists. **Homestead Road from south of Sunrise Boulevard to north of Alabama Road:**

**Construction Project:** This project consists of widening Homestead Road to four lanes. This work will also improve drainage and install new underground utilities. A six-foot sidewalk will be constructed on both sides of the roadway. Motorists should expect lane closures during daytime hours. Project cost is \$14.4 million. The contractor is Stevens and Layton, Inc. The project is expected to be **complete by the end of 2019**. For further questions, contact Lisa Macias, Cella Molnar & Associates at 239-337-1071.

**Island Park Road:** Lee County DOT will perform ditch work along Island Park Road beginning **February 12, 2018 through March 7, 2018**. Motorists should use caution, as crews will be working on the roadside from 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Lee County will provide MOT (Maintenance of Traffic) and have flaggers on hand to control traffic. **Pine Ridge & Summerlin Road:** A contractor for the Summerlin Ridge Development will be doing roadwork on Pine Ridge Road at Summerlin Road starting February 13, 2018 through February 15, 2018 between the hours of 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. Motorist should expect delays and use caution during construction, as there will be nighttime lane closures. **Stoneybrook Golf Drive & Corkscrew Road:** Lee County DOT will be extending the left turn at Stoneybrook Golf Drive from westbound Corkscrew Road starting February 5, 2018. Motorists should use caution during construction, as there will be intermittent lane closures from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. This project should be completed by the **end of March 2018**. **Summerlin Road Paving Project:** Lee County DOT will be paving Summerlin Road from Gladiolus to Cypress Lake Dr. beginning **February 14 through February 20, 2018**. The project will include intermittent lane closures between 7 p.m. and 6 a.m. and will impact both north and southbound traffic. Motorists are encouraged to use caution in this area.
