**Location:** Cypress Street, from Business 41 to River Road; Fourth Way, from Cypress Street to Cabana Avenue; and Lake Street, from River Road to Fourth Way

**I hereby direct that there** be established 20 Miles Per Hour Speed Zones

at the above named locations, in accordance with the attached detail.

This regulation shall be effective upon posting.

**Studies on file:** 24-hr Hi-Star Speed Studies on Cypress Street. Adjacent streets River Road and Cabana Avenue are posted at 25 miles per hour. Resident complaints involve cut-thru traffic traveling from Pondella Road to reach Business 41 specifically during the morning peak period. While traffic volumes are low on these three street segments, the higher-end speeds appear to be associated with the cut-thru traffic, which has been observed by staff. Given the narrow street and right-of-way widths and minimal home setbacks, a maximum posted speed of 20 miles per hour is the staff recommendation based on vehicle test runs. The narrow road widths result in a 2-way 1-lane condition.
