at the above named location, in accordance with the attached detail.


This regulation shall be effective upon posting.

Studies on file: Staff Report dated March 19, 2018. Intersection sight visibility is marginal at this location due to extensive roadside landscaping and limited right-of-way conditions. Based on prior field observations, and given the street network, we estimated that about 2/3rds of the traffic using this intersection is associated with the Boca Grande Isles subdivision. The Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) provides for all-way stops where roads function similarly and restricted sight distance conditions may be present. The recommended all-way stop control is not anticipated to have adverse operational impacts, and may be considered a safety measure.
