**Studies on file:** Intersection Approach Counts show that Joan Avenue is carrying 96 percent of the entering traffic, and is the main street functioning as a residential collector road. Daily volume on Joan Avenue is about 1,500 vehicles per day, with 8<sup>th</sup> Street W. entering traffic at less than 100 vehicles per day. There is no roadway geometric feature which would support the current intersection control with the minor street being preferential. Consistent with the "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices" the minor street should be the stop controlled street.
