I hereby direct that the existing Stop signs controlling Ida Avenue N. be reversed so that Ida Avenue N. is designated as the preferential street

at the above named location, in accordance with the attached detail.

Studies on file: Based on the street network and level of area development, Ida Avenue is the main street. 8th Street dead ends to the east of Ida Avenue and to the west of Joan Avenue. Traffic volumes on 8th Street would be low based on the few residential homes served. Ida Avenue is the preferential street at all cross-streets between Lee Boulevard and 16th Street W. with the exception of 8th Street. There is no roadway geometric feature which would support the current intersection control with the minor street being preferential. Consistent with the "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices" the minor street should be the stop controlled street.
