Studies on file:  Based on the street network and level of area development, Ida Avenue is the main street. 8 <sup>th</sup> Street dead ends to the east of Ida Avenue and to the west of Joan Avenue. Traffic volumes on 8 <sup>th</sup> Street would be low based on the few residential homes served. Ida Avenue is the preferential street at all cross-streets between Lee Boulevard and 16 <sup>th</sup> Street W. with the exception of 8 <sup>th</sup> Street. There is no roadway geometric feature which would support the current intersection control with the minor street being preferential. Consistent with the "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices" the minor street should be the stop controlled street.
