Median being modified on Summerlin Road

Fort Myers, FL, Oct. 19, 2016 – The Lee County Department of Transportation is encouraging motorists on Summerlin Road between Bass and Winkler roads to use caution as a contractor works on a median.

The median opening at the intersection of Park Royal Drive and Summerlin Road is being modified to prohibit left turns from Park Royal onto Summerlin due to an increase in the number of crashes. Intermittent daytime lane closures will occur between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. and the median will be closed during construction. Work should be completed by mid-November.

Traffic on Park Royal Drive destined to the east can use Bass Road to access eastbound Summerlin Road. Left and right turns from Summerlin Road will be allowed once construction is complete.
