Grady Minor & Associates, PA; Greeley & Hansen; Hazen & Sawyer; Hole Montes, Inc.; Ink Engineering; JRI Engineering, Inc.; Johnson Engineering, Inc.; MWH Americas, Inc.; Malcolm Pirnie, Inc.; PBS & J, Inc.; Pitman-Hartenstein & Associates, Inc.; Source, Inc.; WilsonMiller, Inc. for a contract period of two (2) years with the option of renewal for one (1) additional year.

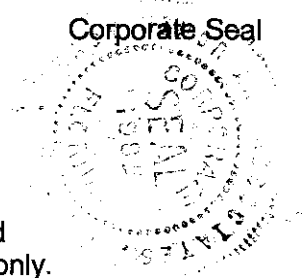

SECTION 1.00 CHANGE(S) TO PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

The "Scope of Professional Services" as set forth in Exhibit "A" of the Professional Services Agreement, or Service Provider Agreement, referred to hereinbefore is hereby supplemented, changed or authorized, so that the CONSULTANT or SERVICE PROVIDER, shall provide and perform the following professional services, tasks, or work as a supplement to, change to, or authorized to, the scope of services previously agreed to and authorized:

**Task No. 1.0** A&W Bulb and Bass Roads Existing Data –

**Task No. 1.1** Review existing Lee County Utility Plans and Data concerning existing water mains, gravity sewer mains and force mains within the Gladiolus Drive Corridor from Pine Ridge Road to Winkler Road.

**Task No. 1.2** Additional Surveying - Survey work will be conducted for the roadway and sidewalk portions of the A&W Bulb and Bass Road projects under the separate LCDOT contract. Additional surveying and subsurface utility location, if necessary, will be performed by subconsultants Jeffrey C. Cooner & Associates and TBE Group, to obtain information about utility location, confirmation of benchmarks, utilities exposed in potholing, and also locations of above ground utility features. These services will be for not only A&W Bulb Road and Bass Road utility adjustments, but also for final design of Gladiolus Road utility adjustments.

**Task No. 1.3** Data Extraction – In this task, data tables will be created indicating the start and end stations of existing utilities, the alignment offsets from the road centerline of these mains, their potential conflict locations, and their elevations at crossings

**Task No. 2.0** A&W Bulb and Bass Roads Existing Utility Plan –

**Task No. 2.1** General Project Management – This task includes preparing communications, meeting with the client, and quality assurance coordination.

**Task No. 2.2** Existing Utility Plan – From completion of Task No. 1, prepare existing Utility Plans showing water mains, gravity sewer mains, force mains, and any reuse mains within the two corridors of A&W Bulb and Bass Roads. Lee County DOT Plans will be utilized to show the existing utilities.

**Task No. 3.0** A&W Bulb and Bass Roads 30 Percent Coordination –

**Task No. 3.1** 30% Coordination General Project Management – This task includes preparing communications, meeting with the client, and quality assurance coordination.

- Task No. 3.2** Conflict location Identification – Locations where utility crossings or proposed drainage and transportation features may limit the feasible alignment relocations will be identified in this task. Feasible alignments or adjustments will be included in tabulated data for further development in the 60% Conceptual Design stage.
- Task No. 3.3** Conceptual Design – Conceptual utilities alignments that minimize conflicts will be created in plan drawings. Select profile views will be created for conflict locations. These 30% conceptual designs will be coordinated with Lee County Utilities and DOT prior to progressing to the 60% design stage.
- Task No. 3.4** Meeting: Discuss 30% Conceptual Design – Project engineers from Q. Grady Minor will attend meetings to present the existing utility plan work product and to present plans and profiles of 30% conceptual design for up to two (2) meetings.
- Task No. 4.0** Task 4.0 A&W Bulb and Bass Roads Coordination to Final –
- Task No. 4.1** A&W Bulb and Bass Roads 60% Design Review – Upon receipt of the 60% (Basic Plan) from Lee County DOT, review the Plan for conflicts with the utility realignments caused by drainage structures, walls, light pole foundations, and subsurface obstructions such as signal cables. Using surveying provided by Jeffrey C. Cooner & Associates under Task 2, the horizontal and vertical locations of these conflicts will be verified. The listing of anticipated relocations and utility adjustments will be finalized in this task.
- Task No. 4.2** A&W Bulb and Bass Roads 60% Utility Plans Project Management – This task includes preparing communications, meeting with the client to review the 60% design, advancing the design to the final bid package, and quality assurance coordination.
- Task No. 4.3** A&W Bulb and Bass Roads 60% Utility Plans – Based upon approval of the utilities to be relocated and adjusted, prepare the Utility Relocation Adjustment plans for Gladiolus Drive Widening from the 30% to 60% level. These 60% plans will include profile views of utility mains and select roadway crossings. Potholing and field survey will be included in this task to verify subsurface locations of utilities. These plans will also include details of valves and appurtenant facilities, based on the standard Lee County Utilities Details. The 30% design drawings that have been prepared for this project will be the Base Plans for this work. The 60% submittal will be one hard copy set of plans.
- Task No. 4.4** A&W Bulb and Bass Roads 90% Utility Plans – A period of review will follow the 60% submittal. The review comments from the 60% to 90% will be incorporated to advance the complete plan, profiles, and details from draft design to the 90% level. Changes will also be made that correspond to revisions in the Lee County DOT's roadway and drainage design from 60% to the 90% level, as required. The 90% submittal will be one hard copy set of plans.
- Task No. 4.5** A&W Bulb and Bass Roads 100% Utility Plans– The review from the 90% to 100% will be incorporated to prepare the Utility Relocation Adjustment plans for A&W and Bass Roads to 100% design. Besides incorporating review comments from the 90% plans, communications will be included to convey the sequence for abandoning existing utility mains, construction of the new utility mains, and construction sequence of the roadway and storm drainage improvements. Quantities calculations will be conducted to produce the Engineer's Estimate of Cost. The Technical and General Specifications for the design will be prepared using the standard Lee County Specifications. These plans will also include details of valves and appurtenant facilities, based on the standard Lee County Utilities Details. The 90% design drawings that have been prepared for this project will be the Base Plans for this work. The 100% submittal will be one hard copy set of plans.

**Task No. 4.6** A&W Bulb and Bass Roads Final Utility Plans, Bid and Contract Documents – After verification of the 100% submittal, the relocation and adjustment plans will be finalized with Technical and General Specifications to be part of the bid package. Bid packages will be prepared separately for A&W Bulb and Bass Road Improvements. The Specifications will be based on the standard Lee County Specifications. The design plans, specifications, and Engineer's Estimate of Cost will be prepared with a bid schedule. The bid schedule will be prepared for bidding as joint projects with the roadway/sidewalk/storm drainage work. It is understood that Lee County Utilities will make reproductions of the plans for bidding purposes. Therefore, only one set of hard copy plans and bid documents along with electronic files of the same will be submitted as project final documents.

**Task No. 4.7** A&W Bulb and Bass Roads Permitting – This task will involve preparation of the permit applications and supporting documents for an FDEP Wastewater Construction Permit and Florida Department of Health Water Main Construction Permit. This task excludes any Environmental Permitting or Development Order Permitting, both of which are assumed to be within the scope of the Lee County DOT road widening project. All Permit Fees shall be paid directly by Lee County.

**Task No. 5.0** Gladiolus Drive Widening Utility Plans –

**Task No. 5.1** Gladiolus Drive 60% Design Review – Upon receipt of the 60% (Basic Plan) from Lee County DOT, review the Plan for conflicts with the utility realignments caused by drainage structures, walls, light pole foundations, and subsurface obstructions such as signal cables. Using surveying provided by Jeffrey C. Cooner & Associates under Task 2, the horizontal and vertical locations of these conflicts will be verified. The listing of anticipated relocations and utility adjustments will be finalized in this task.

**Task No. 5.2** Gladiolus Drive Utility Project Management – This task includes preparing communications, meeting with the client to review the 60% design, advancing the design to the final bid package, and quality assurance coordination.

**Task No. 5.3** Gladiolus Drive Utility Widening 60% Utility Relocation/Adjustment Plans – Based upon approval of the listing of utilities to be relocated and adjusted, prepare the Utility Relocation Adjustment plans for Gladiolus Drive Widening from the 30% to 60% level. These 60 % plans will include profile views of utility mains and select roadway crossings. Potholing and field survey will be included in this task to verify subsurface locations of utilities. These plans will also include details of valves and appurtenant facilities, based on the standard Lee County Utilities Details. The 30% design drawings that have been prepared for this project will be the Base Plans for this work. The 60% submittal will be one hard copy set of plans.

**Task No. 5.4** Gladiolus Drive Utility Widening 90% Utility Relocation/Adjustment Plans – A period of review will follow the 60% submittal. The review comments from the 60% to 90% will be incorporated to advance the complete plan and profiles from draft design to the 90% level. Changes will also be made that correspond to revisions in the Lee County DOT's roadway and drainage design from 60% to the 90% level, as required. The 90% submittal will be one hard copy set of plans.

**Task No. 5.5** Gladiolus Drive Utility Widening 100% Utility Relocation/Adjustment Plans – The review from the 90% to 100% will be incorporated to prepare the Utility Relocation Adjustment plans for Gladiolus Drive to 100% design. Besides incorporating review comments from the 90% plans, quantities will be calculated to produce the Engineer's Estimate of Cost, and the sequencing of abandoning existing utility mains, construction of the new utility mains,

and construction sequence of the roadway and storm drainage improvements will be finalized. The 100% submittal will be one hard copy set of plans.

**Task No. 5.6** Gladiolus Drive Utility Widening Final Plans, Bid and Contract Documents – After verification of the 100% submittal, the relocation and adjustment plans will be finalized with Technical and General Specifications to be part of the bid package. These Specifications will be based on the standard Lee County Specifications. The design plans, specifications, and Engineer's Estimate of Cost will be prepared with a bid schedule. The bid schedule will be prepared for use in bidding as a Joint Project with the roadway/storm drainage project. It is understood that Lee County Utilities will make reproductions of the plans for bidding purposes. Therefore, only one set of hard copy plans and bid documents along with electronic files of the same will be submitted as project final documents.

**Task No. 5.7** Gladiolus Drive Utility Permitting – This task will involve preparation of the permit applications and supporting documents for an FDEP Wastewater Construction Permit and Florida Department of Health Water Main Construction Permit. This task excludes any Environmental Permitting or Development Order Permitting, both of which are assumed to be within the scope of the Lee County DOT road widening project. All Permit Fees shall be paid directly by Lee County.
