**9. Background:** In accordance with Lee County Ordinance, 04-18, the Enhanced 9-1-1 Telephone System Program Manager shall recommend approval for street name changes of existing plats within the unincorporated areas of Lee County and under authority of the City of Sanibel. This name change will not affect the addresses of those residing on this street. All residents have been notified and we have not received any complaints about this action considered an aesthetic change to the name. The dash (-) in the street name is an unnecessary character and is not acknowledged when the residents use this name verbally in an emergency situation. This change will simplify the search results when the street name is entered into the computer-aided dispatch in an effort to quickly locate the caller's location on the GIS mapping equipment in the 9-1-1 centers.
