9. Background:

The original blue sheet (20040010), Resolution, and Agreement for this project was approved by the BoCC on 2-3-04, as Consent Agenda Item 9d. At that time, it was planned to landscape the I-75 interchanges at both Daniels Pkwy. and Corkscrew Rd. under the same resolution and agreement. The agreement included up to \$200,000 in funding from FDOT with a match from Lee County. Since that time, the state has advanced their construction schedule for the Daniels at I-75 interchange improvements to 2008. Due to these upcoming improvements at the Daniels and I-75 interchange, FDOT staff has recommended, and staff agrees, that we abandon that portion of this project and focus our efforts on the Corkscrew and I-75 interchange.

This project may be limited to the unlandscaped medians of Corkscrew Rd. in FDOT's jurisdiction. FDOT funds will be used solely within FDOT's jurisdiction. FDOT requires two original executed resolutions and three executed agreements with the County before authorizing the expenditure of funds.

This landscape and irrigation project was approved by the Lee County Roadway Landscape Advisory Committee on September 4, 2001.

WHEREAS, Lee County desires to landscape and irrigate the Corkscrew Road and I-75 Interchange; and

WHEREAS, Lee County desires to enter into a Local Agency Program Supplemental Agreement with the State of Florida Department of Transportation (Department) FM No. 414079-1, whereby the Department will compensate the County for costs directly related to landscaping and irrigation at Corkscrew Road and I-75 Interchange.
