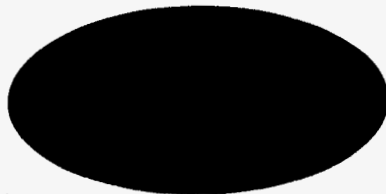
- Whereas:** The Boy Scouts of America has been at the forefront of instilling timeless values in youth since its founding in 1910; and
