RESOLUTION

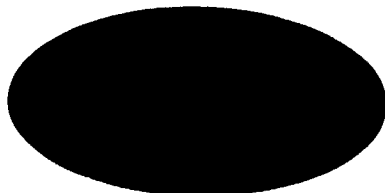
