

Lee County Ordinance 08-08.8(3) Exempt Products as of January 2011

The following products are exempt from the Lee County Landscape & Fertilizer Best Management Practices Ordinance for use during the months of June through September:

- Mulch, yard waste compost or similar soil amendments that is primarily organic in nature. Landscape products that do not make nutritional claims for nutrients or micro-nutrients usually fall into this category.
- Products that do make nutritional claims on the bag, but the first two numbers are zeroes. The summer-time restriction is for nitrogen and phosphorus and products that bear the 0-0-# (the # being any number) on the label are exempt.
- Products granted exemption during the summer months under Ordinance 08-08;
 - B and B Organics Soil Builder. B and B Organics can be found easily on the Internet and at local nurseries. This product is not endorsed by Lee County.
 - OrganicLee: This product was recently approved by Lee County. It can be purchased at the Lee County Resource Recovery Facility.
