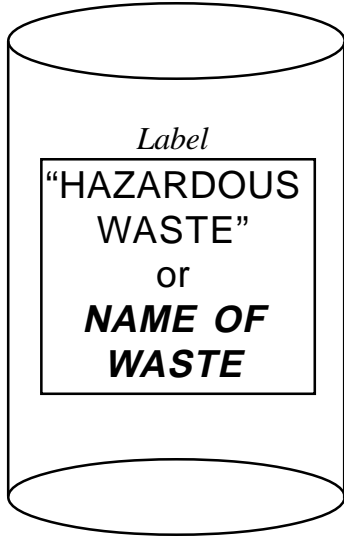


Labeling Guidance

For all Generator types:

- All waste drums/storage tanks must be labeled with the waste contained within or with the words "Hazardous Waste". **It is suggested that you specifically identify the waste to better assist authorities, in case of emergency.**

For Small Quantity Generators(SQGs)/ Large Quantity Generators (LQGs) :

- Containers must also be labeled with the accumulation start date. Hazardous waste may not be accumulated on site for longer than 180 days for SQGs (or 270 days if generator must ship the waste greater than 200 miles) and no longer than 90 days for LQGs.
- The FDEP/EPA ID number must be included on the label.
- Generator's name, full address and phone number.

****SPECIAL NOTE:** For wastes that are recycled (i.e., Used Oil, Used Antifreeze, etc.), **DO NOT** label "Hazardous Waste". These wastes, and others are **NOT** considered hazardous waste when destined for recycling. Please contact the P² Program at (941)479-8126 for clarification or questions.
