Dog Park Rules



Open Dawn to Dusk

This recreational area is set aside solely as an off-leash play area that is self-monitored by users. Entry into this area is at the risk of the dog owner. All owners are responsible and liable for any injury and / or damage to property, persons or other animals caused by their dog(s). Lee County will not be responsible for injuries to visiting dogs, their owners, or others using the park. Prevent problems by supervising your dog at all times. All bites to people must be reported to the Lee County branch of the Florida Department of Health at (239) 332-9580.

Dogs:

- Dogs must be vaccinated and owners must be able to provide proof.
- Dogs in heat and puppies less than 4 months old are not permitted in the park.
- Aggressive and sick dogs are not permitted in the park.
- Maximum of 3 dogs per person.
- Dogs must be on-leash prior to entering and leaving the park.
- Dogs must be under voice control of owners at all times.

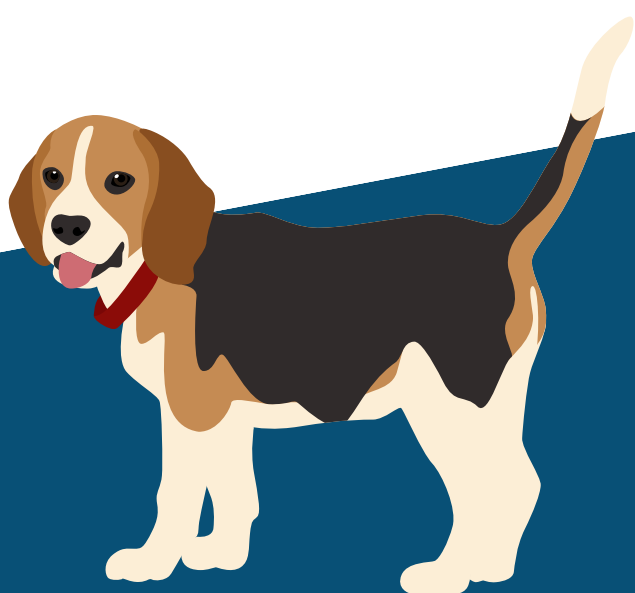
Parents and Guardians of Children:

- Children under 5 should not be brought into fenced / off-leash area.
- Children under 12 must be accompanied and strictly supervised by an adult.
- Children should not run or interfere with dogs at play.

General:

- No smoking in the off-leash area.
- Food, treats, alcohol and glass containers are not allowed.
- Owners must remain in fenced area with dogs.
- Owners must stop aggressive dog behavior immediately.
- Clean up after your dog immediately. Waste bags and disposal bins are provided.
- Fill any holes your dog dogs.
