Improvements set for Lee County's Bat House Park in Matlacha

Matlacha, FL, July 18, 2016 — Improvements to the Lee County-owned Bat House Park are slated to begin this week, July 18. During this time, the park – a popular fishing destination – will be closed for construction purposes. The Matlacha Bridge will remain open for fishing.

The bat house at the new Bat House Park is already in place. Next, the county plans to renovate the former historic restaurant building to create ADA restrooms, create a covered porch and add an ADA ramp leading to a new parking lot. Benches and fish-cleaning tables will be installed. The anticipated park re-opening is mid-December.
